Morning routines:

Once your child is in full time, you can arrive at school from 8:35am and the classroom doors will open for your child to start their day. The register will be taken at 8:45am and the gates will be locked. If you are late for any reason, please sign in at the school office. It is important that your child brings their book bag/rucksack in each day.

Reading:

Reading at home is very important. We ask that all children read at home every day. This could be just a small part of their reading book and sometimes a library book or picture book. Please sign your child's reading record when you have read together, this can be a quick date and signature if you are short on time. Reading records will be checked daily. Your child will read with an adult and change their book on a weekly basis on their reading day. (We will let you know their reading day once we start sending books home.)

PE days:

We have P.E. once a week. Our P.E. day will be a **Thursday**
Please note that PE will not start for our children for the first few weeks and it will then begin with children just taking off shoes and socks to get used to go into the hall.)

Please ensure that your child comes into school dressed smartly in their P.E. kit. This includes the new P.E. uniform...
